To **add** a material, select the green plus sign at the bottom of the list.

You will need a **description, price, and unit** for your item. For example, if you are charging by the square foot, you should select 'sq ft' from the Unit(s) dropdown menu.

The cost field is optional, and it is not added in to the customer's job price.

Note: items on the materials tab will not have financing programs applied to them, so for larger job additions, you should use the **Accessories** or **Add-On** tabs.

To **deactivate** or **remove** a material, 'grab' the line item by the blue arrow icon, and **drag** it down to the Inactive section. You can also use the blue arrow icon to re-order materials within the Active list, to help you sort them in a logical way for your workflow.
